CONDITIONS

1. The competition will be played in accordance with the RULES OF GOLF as laid down by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews.
2. ALL ENTRIES must be submitted on an official entry form together with entry fees by not later than MONDAY 19th MARCH 2012. *Handicap limit 18. Limited to the first 132 entries.*
3. ENTRY FEE: Members - £18.00; Visitors - £48.00
(No entry fee will be refunded due to scratching after the closing date.)
4. Open to MEMBERS OF GOLF CLUBS AFFILIATED TO THE ENGLISH (or other National) GOLF UNION. Juniors under the age of 18 may compete provided they hold a handicap of 18 or less.
5. *Handicaps at the date of entry for all visitors must be confirmed by their Home Club Secretary on the Official Entry Form with Union ID Numbers. Any change in handicap after entry should be confirmed by a handicap certificate when registering on the day of the competition.*
6. Ties will be decided on the last 18, 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes of the round played of the East Course or such other manner as the Committee may decide upon.
7. Disputes will be decided upon by the Committee whose decision will be final.
8. The Committee reserve the right to make any alterations to the above conditions and to refuse any entry without giving reasons.
9. Players may use devices that measure distance only (e.g. GPS). Such devices must not measure any other condition. Please refer to the Club's local rule.
